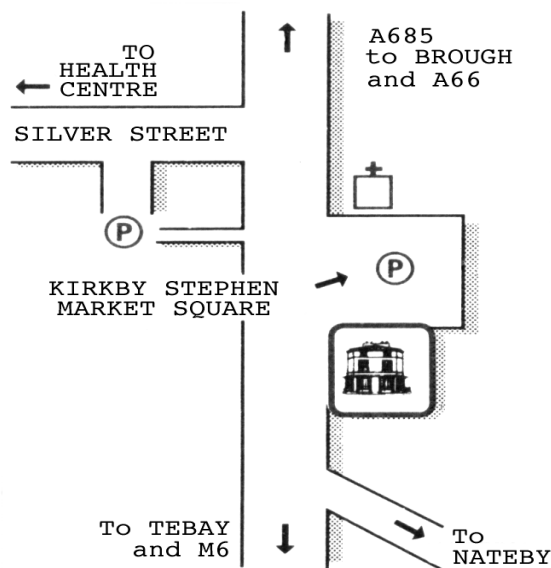

HOW TO FIND OUR PRACTICE

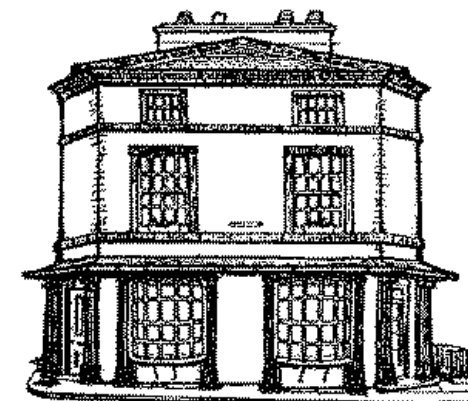

REGISTERING WITH OUR PRACTICE

We are not currently accepting any new NHS patients. We are accepting new patients on a private basis.

If you would like to join the practice as a private patient you can telephone to make an appointment, or you are very welcome to come in to meet us and have a look around. Either way we will give you a new patient pack with all the information. You can make a private appointment to see the dentist for an initial half hour assessment of your dental health.

Dental Health Plans. Once you are dentally fit we encourage patients to register with Denplan. One of the many benefits of being a Denplan member is long term preventive dental care and peace of mind. You pay a small monthly direct debit payment through your bank and experience has shown that patients enjoy the security of knowing what their dental care will cost, and being free from sudden unpredictable & sometimes large bills.
