HOW TO PAY

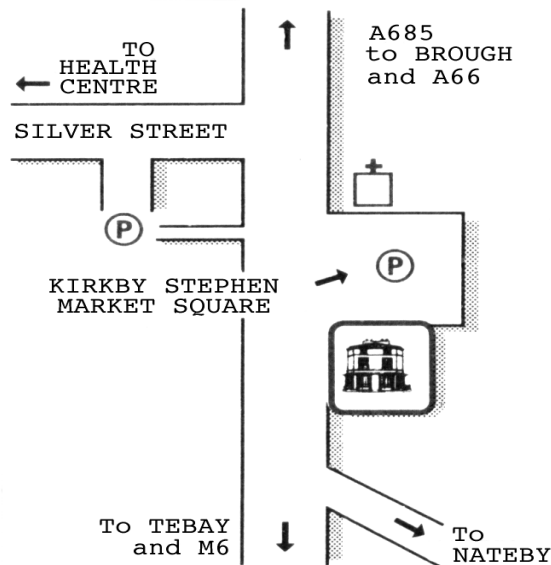

Please note that we charge £25 for missed appointments and unreasonably late cancellations in order to keep treatment costs down for everyone.

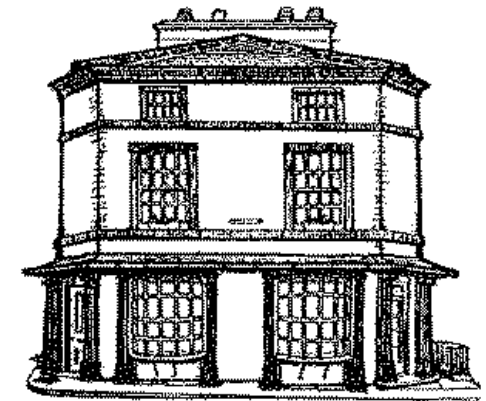
HOW TO FIND OUR PRACTICE

REGISTERING WITH OUR PRACTICE
